Academic Program

Upon arrival, a placement test will be administered to each student to determine the level of English proficiency in accordance with the Common European Framework. Students are grouped in small classes led by CELTA (or equivalent) certified teachers.

Weekly classes provide 15 hours of engaging and informative English language study with a focus on task-based learning that strengthens English communication skills through common topics and tasks. Certificates are provided to each student after successful completion of their coursework during a graduation ceremony.
